

KEY POST-Vaccination Points:

The vaccine will NOT cause a positive COVID-19 result. If at any point going forward, you have a positive COVID-19 test (positive antigen test, positive RT/PCR or NAT, etc.) it is not attributed to the vaccine. The vaccine will not cause a positive on any of these lab tests for SARS-COV-2 (COVID-19).

Continue all masking & PPE mandates as before vaccination ---- just because vaccinated, do NOT decrease PPE requirements or masking mandates.

Common & expected side affects, mild to moderate --- fever, chills, fatigue, muscle aches, fatigue, headache. Vaccine-related side effects, as listed, expect to last no longer than 2 days. Cough, shortness of breath, rhinorrhea, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell are **not** consistent with post-vaccination symptoms, and instead may be symptoms of SARS-CoV-2 or another infection.

We are asked by CDC to please encourage all recipients of the vaccine to **enroll in V-safe**, can self-register immediately after receiving vaccination.
